**WAYACHTS: A RENEWED WAKE 46 AND THE NEW PROJECT OF THE WAKE 66 AT THE NEXT FESTIVAL DE LA PLAISANCE IN CANNES**

**After one year from the international presentation held in Cannes last September 2007, the Wake 46 return to the Festival de la Plaisance in Cannes with some important stylistic news (both externally and internally). The Cannes boat show will be also the opportunity to present the project of the new Wake 66.**

Milan, July 2008. The next boat show in Cannes will be full of news for Wayachts. The Milan based shipyard in fact will present a new version of the Wake 46, the 14 metres motoryacht that has got a great success with public and press for the innovative onboard space design.

So that, Wayachts, after one year of experience, will display in Cannes the Wake 46 2009 model which main news will be:

- bigger swimming platform A
- new roll bar A
- different T-Top. A

In details, the swimming platform has been lengthened of 60 cm to increase the total surface (now of 3,5 sqm), meanwhile the over all length will be no 14,40 m.

The roll bar has been redesigned: it is now leaned forward to follow the air intake line giving a more sporty effect.

The coverage of the cockpit has also changed. Now there is a T-Top made by a unique piece of darkened lexan supported by two parallel stainless steel bars to grant the maximum shadow on the pilot station and the cockpit; but, for the sun lovers, the wonderful chaise longue on the open stern and the wide sunpad at bow will remain.

Internally, the new model will have a three master rooms and two large bathroom configuration.

The Wake 46, that for the innovative design has been re-defined Live-Around, rather than walk-around will have a bigger friend. The Festival de la Plaisance in fact will give to Wayachts the opportunity to present the project of the new Wake 66, designed, as for the 46, by the yacht designer Francesco Rolla and which will be a 20,20 metres with interesting project solutions specially for the interiors.
